Louie (1899-1975) was married to Ruth Cherington; they had Marvin and Margie.



Fri Jan 24 – Helped Dad start his car by pulling it with a horse. Took Marie home. Brought the car home at night. Helen & I packed clothes after supper.

Sat Jan 25 – Borrowed a trailer & Guy helped me move 1 load to Campbell's. Dad went to Lloyds & I brought them home & kept the car all night.

Sun Jan 26 – Moved another load of furniture to Campbell's. Froze Dad's car up. Helen & I went to Red Oak on the train at night.

Mon Jan 27 – Lela gave Helen her swagger suit. I bought new overshoes, Helen a pair of shoes & other clothes Went to show at night at Red Oak, "The Bride Comes Home."

Mon Apr 6 – Arrived Washington D.C. 7:50 A.M. Wayne Lambertson met us at the train & helped us find an apartment. I have to stay in bed with mumps.





Wed Nov 4 – Worked. Warm for this time of year. Roosevelt won Presidency by greatest majority ever accorded any President. Hooray!




Wed Dec 16 – Worked. Rain. Helen called the office. Met her at Murphy's & bought Christmas presents. Wrapped them at night.
