Diary of Dale Gardner 1962

As this diary from 1962 begins, Dale, Helen, and Dalene live at 3727 Reservoir Boulevard, Columbia Heights, MN, and Dale is a government Gauger at Ed Phillips & Sons ("EPS") bottling plant. They rent out their second floor apartment and a basement room. Stan and Judy live in Reseda, CA, and Stan is a computer programmer at SDC (System Development Corporation) in Santa Monica. During the year, Dalene moves to Santa Monica and starts working at SDC. Dale is 52 years old and Helen is 50. Dale and Helen drive a 1960 Plymouth. Stan and Judy drive a 1957 Chevrolet. Dalene drives a 1961 Plymouth Valiant.

Dale and Helen celebrate their 30th wedding anniversary, and during the year, become "empty-nesters," but they drive to California a second time in December to spend Christmas with their Left Coast children and grandchildren. Johnny Carson takes over hosting duties of "The Tonight Show." Another entertainer, Ernie Kovacs, dies, as does Eleanor Roosevelt. The 1962 Academy Award for Best Picture goes to "West Side Story." Movies released this year include "Lawrence of Arabia," "The Manchurian Candidate," and "To Kill a Mockingbird." Mariner II, the first interplanetary probe, reaches Venus.

Mon Jan 1 – Holiday. Watched the Rose Parade & Rose Bowl game today. We were right there in Pasadena. Had a beautiful day for it, temp was 80° in afternoon.

Tue Jan 2 – Annual leave. 82° in the shade on Stan's front porch in Reseda. I rested today. Called Marie Kimmel, we are going home together tomorrow. Packed for the trip tomorrow.

Wed Jan 3 – Annual leave. Left Stan's at 5 AM. Met Marie in Barstow. Drove 719 miles today to Gallup, New Mexico, to stay all night.

Thu Jan 4 – Annual leave. 10° above at Gallup, New Mexico. Arrived Greensburg, Kansas, at 9:30 PM in a snowstorm. Stayed all night here.

Fri Jan 5 – Annual leave. Drove all day in a blizzard from Greensburg, Kansas, to Excelsior Springs, Missouri. Stayed in a nice Ranger Court motel. Had a nice supper at motel, & to bed.

Sat Jan 6 – Took until 1 PM to start the Valiant. Arrived Osceola at 3:30 PM. Had supper there. Drove on to Mpls by midnight. Drove 4,637 miles since Dec 26th.

Sun Jan 7 – Unwinding at home in Mpls. Unpacking & resting, etc at home.

Wed Jan 10 – EPS. 17° below. Stayed below zero all day. Betty & sister & baby visited us awhile in the evening. Letter from Mother. I wrote her a card. Dalene to class.

Sat Jan 13 – Helen & I to the downtown library, & to Apache to pick up our movies of the Rose Parade & Rose Bowl. Movies are good. Lunch at Murphy's at Apache.

Sun Jan 14 – Helen & I figured on our income tax. Watched Pro Bowl game on TV. Called Stan & Judy about Dalene going out there to work after school is out.

Thu Jan 18 – 28° below zero, a record for this date in Mpls.

Mon Feb 5 – EPS. Letter from Mother. Sonja Sopher called, she is coming up this week-end. Dalene started cleaning her room.

Sat Feb 10 – Helen & I downtown to the library, & stamp redemption center for towels & washcloths. Sonja Sopher & Jan Fronson drove up from Iowa City to see Dinny & stay all night.

Sun Feb 11 – Sonja Sopher & Janet Fronson here until about 3 PM. Dreary day, foggy in the morning & damp all day. Talked to Stan & Judy on the phone. They are coming May 22nd, go home on June 13th.

Wed Feb 14 – Jean left Teri Lee here to spend the evening. Dalene to the high school for a musical.

Wed Feb 21 – EPS. Merle Osterquist phoned to tell us Rod Mead died yesterday, unexpectedly. I called Chasteen, Peterson, & Arth.

Fri Feb 23 – EPS. Letter from Mother. Decided not to go to Mead's funeral tomorrow.

Mon Feb 26 – EPS. Dalene took us to the Pancake House for nice supper. She & Betty Patrow shoveled the driveway to Mrs. Magnuson's garage for Betty's car. Wrote Merle Osterquist a letter.

Thu Mar 1 – EPS. 32° below at 2:30 AM, coldest March 1 on record. Didn't get above zero all day.

Sat Mar 3 – Letter from Merle Osterquist. Helen & I looked at mobile homes in the afternoon. Blizzard all evening. 30 years married.

Fri Mar 9 – EPS. Received federal income tax return. Ate supper at Candlelight Café. Took Helen to the library. Watched a late movie.

Fri Mar 16 – EPS. Bob Nash at Phillips, he & I to Distillers Distributing Co. for interview. Betty came up for TV. Dalene went bowling at 10:15 PM with girls.

Thu Mar 22 – EPS. I watched Minnesota state high school basketball tourney at night on TV.

Fri Mar 23 – EPS. Watched high school basketball on TV all evening.


