Diary of Dale Gardner 1966

As this diary from 1966 begins, Dale and Helen live at 3727 Reservoir Boulevard, Columbia Heights, MN, and Dale works at Ed Phillips & Sons ("EPS") bottling plant. They rent out their second floor apartment and a basement room. Stan and Judy live in Fridley, MN, and Stan works at CDC (Control Data Corporation) in Arden Hills. Dalene lives in Santa Monica and works at SDC. Dale is 56 years old and Helen is 54. They drive a 1965 Plymouth. Stan and Judy drive a 1963 Ford station wagon. Dalene drives a 1961 Valiant.

Dale and Helen arrive in Osceola on New Year's Day for a short visit. Dale marks 30 years with the Civil Service. In May, they drive to California to vacation with Dalene, visiting family along the way. Later, they attend a Schaffer reunion in Des Moines. Helen turns 55. Dalene takes her first airplane trip, round trip to Des Moines for a Gardner, Williams, and Machlan reunion in September. The same month, Jettie turns 85. Helen and Dale buy their first color TV. Dalene arrives in Minneapolis on December 10 on vacation for the rest of the year.

Ronald Reagan enters politics, becoming governor of California. Author Jacqueline Susann has her first novel, "Valley of the Dolls," published. Simon and Garfunkel release "Sounds of Silence." Pampers creates the first disposable diaper. The world's first vertical take-off and landing jet, the Harrier, is introduced in the UK, and hovercraft service begins over the English Channel. Sat Jan 1 – Arrived in Chariton 5:30 AM. Train over an hour late. Wilma met us. Walked down to Don & Opal's. Walked to Marie's & watched the Rose Parade on her color set, also watched some bowl games. To Mother's in the afternoon & all night.

Sun Jan 2 – At Mother's. Went to Don & Opal's for dinner & pro football on TV. To highway café for supper with Wilma. Visited at Marie's awhile after supper.

Mon Jan 3 – Annual leave. I walked uptown to newspaper office & renewed our yearly subscription in Osceola. Bought a City of Osceola map. Saw Marie. Ruth took us to Chariton to noon train, we made it by 2 minutes. Home in Mpls by 7:30 PM. Stan met us. To Bridgeman's for hamburgers.

Tue Jan 4 – EPS. Back to work. Apache for supper. To bed 10:30.

Fri Jan 7 – EPS. Had the car washed at Apache. Watched a late movie, "Happy Anniversary." Good. To bed at midnight.

Sun Jan 16 – Helen & I worked on income tax computations. Supper at Sweden House.

Tue Jan 25 – EPS. Talked to Dalene in the evening, may drive out in May to see her. Helen called a man about new counter top.

Fri Jan 28 – EPS. 28° below zero at 7 AM & 11 PM. Warmed up to about 19° below. Started a savings account at Columbia Heights bank. First savings account we ever had. Good movie, "I'd Climb the Highest Mountain," on TV.

Sat Jan 29 – 28° below zero at 7 AM. Warmed up to -8° by midnight. We had supper at Bridgeman's. A man gave us a \$96 estimate on a counter top.

Sun Feb 6 – Stans came for awhile after church. Supper at Sweden House. Dalene called, wants us to come out in May, we probably will.

Mon Feb 7 – High 34°. First day in the last 29 it got above freezing. Decided to have counter-top & new faucet & sink installed. Called Mr. Kluck (plumber) & told him. Talked to Mr. Vassar earlier about counter top.

Tue Feb 8 – EPS. Mailed state & Federal tax returns at Apache. Supper at Captain's Cove. Told Mr. Vassar to go ahead with the new counter-top.

Sun Feb 13 – I have a head cold. Called Nickolay to tell him I won't be to work for a couple of days.

Tue Feb 15 – Sick leave. Going back to work tomorrow. Haven't had a cigar since last Thursday. Watched lowa beat Minnesota in basketball on TV.

Wed Feb 16 – EPS. Back to work. I went to the library after work. Helen has the flu.

Sat Feb 19 – I watched Iowa beat Ohio State in basketball in afternoon. Letter & pictures from Dalene. We phoned her about 10:30.

Wed Feb 23 – EPS. Carlson, Coulombe, & Nickolay at EPS today. Letter from Mother.

Sat Feb 26 – Nice day. Roast beef dinner. Watched Minnesota beat Illinois in basketball on TV. Watched a late movie.

Mon Feb 28 – EPS. Supper at Apache. Watched Minnesota beat Indiana in basketball on TV.

Tue Mar 1 – EPS. High 45° & sunny. Fine day. Helen to Judy's today to help hem up some dresses. We stayed for supper & played caroms in the evening. Card from Dalene.

Thu Mar 3 – EPS. Married 34 years ago tonight. Sweden House for supper. Bought a new carom board & played it in the evening. Stan & Judy gave us carnations & roses.

Mon Mar 7 – EPS. Had the car washed. Vassar called, they are going to put new sink, faucet, & counter-top in Wednesday. Supper at Sweden House. Watched a late movie, "You're My Everything" with Dan Dailey & Ann Baxter.



Tue Mar 8 – EPS. Mr. Kluck came & disconnected the kitchen sink & faucet in the evening.

Wed Mar 9 – EPS. Mr. Vassar put our new counter-top on, in the kitchen, nice. Watched a late movie.

Thu Mar 10 – EPS. Record high of 55°. Plumbers came & hooked up our new sink.

Sun Mar 13 – High 47° & sunny most all afternoon. Watched Philadelphia beat New York in probasketball. Good game.

Mon Mar 14 – EPS. Letter from Lela, they're coming up Saturday.

Thu Mar 17 – EPS. High 71°. Beautiful day, partly cloudy, & windy. Helen & I looked at travel trailers & mobile homes.

Sat Mar 19 – Nice day, snow all gone. Watched Texas-Western beat Kentucky in NCAA final, on TV. Gene & Lela gave us a nice world globe.

Sun Mar 20 – Up & breakfast at 9 AM. Gene & Lela here. Nice spring day, high 58°. Supper at Sweden House & then to see Teri & then to Stan's for awhile.

Mon Mar 21 – EPS. Nice day. To N.E. Trailer Sales to look at some travel trailers & then home.

Wed Mar 23 – Blizzard, worst since Nov 11, 1940. Over 14 inches snow. Most businesses closed. EPS closed. Government offices closed. University of Minnesota closed, first time ever. No mail deliveries. Stayed home all day. Stopped snowing in afternoon & quiet at night. High 23°. Administrative leave for today, not charged to annual or sick leave.

Thu Mar 24 – EPS. Had the driveway plowed out, first time this winter. To Apache for supper & then home to watch 2 high school basketball tournament games in the evening.

Fri Mar 25 – EPS. Letter from Mother. Watched 2 high school basketball games at night, one was 3 overtimes, Edina over Henning.

Sat Mar 26 – Nice day. Letter from Lela. Watched Edina beat Duluth for state high school basketball championship, on TV. To bed after a late movie.

Sun Mar 27 – Beautiful day, except for the snow on the ground. High 40°. Watched pro basketball in the afternoon. Good roast beef dinner, at home.

Sun Apr 10 – Helen fixed Sunday dinner for Stan & Judy. Good meal, lots of everything. Talked to Mother about 8 PM.

Wed Apr 13 – EPS. Bought a new Rand-McNally road atlas. Helen & I to Mr. & Mrs. Claude Larson's to meet them & see their new mobile home. Nice people. Watched a late movie, "Marty." Very good. To bed 12:15.



Sat Apr 16 – Helen & I put all the screens on today. Beautiful day, 65° & a little wind, mostly clear. Marie, Mother, & Mary came at 5 PM to visit until Monday. Supper at Sweden House. Played caroms in the evening, etc. Marie & I went over to Bridgeman's for ice cream.

Sun Apr 17 – Rainy day. Took Mother & Mary out to Stan & Judy's in the afternoon, then home at 3:30.

Mon Apr 18 – EPS. Stan brought us AAA tour books at breakfast time. Carlson & Marose at EPS for bottling inspection. Steak supper at home. Watched Academy Awards at night till 11:35.

Thu Apr 21 – EPS. Letter from Dalene. Helen called Lela to tell her we're coming there tomorrow night.

Fri Apr 22 – EPS. 30 years with U.S. Civil Service. Helen & I drove to Estherville by 9:15. Stayed all night with Gene & Lela. Rain at night. Gene & Lela bought a new Mercury yesterday.

Sat Apr 23 – Helen & I drove from Estherville to Omaha by 4 PM. Nice day for driving. Stayed at Lamplighter Motor Hotel & went to Merle Osterquist's retirement party there. Lasted until 2 AM. Good time all evening. Saw a lot of people we hadn't seen for years.

Sun Apr 24 – Helen & I left Lamplighter Inn at 7:40 AM & drove from Omaha to Estherville. Dinner with Gene & Lela at smorgasbord there. Back home, sandwich at Bridgeman's. 377 miles today.

Tue Apr 26 – EPS. High 42° & chilly, cloudy. Wrote Marie a letter about routing to Alaska for Merle.

Thu Apr 28 – EPS. Picked up the pictures of Omaha retirement party & some taken at Phillips too with Instamatic camera. Called Dalene to tell her we would be there on May 14th.

Sat Apr 30 – Sprayed weed killer on the lawn. Marie sent literature on Alaska, for Osterquist.

Sun May 1 – Beautiful day but cool. High 50°. Bought Helen a new Waltham wristwatch & Instamatic 104 camera & film. Lunch at Burger King, supper at home. Marie is 48 today.

Mon May 2 – EPS. Helen & I to Downtown Plymouth to get bill of sale for Dalene.

Tue May 3 – EPS. Dietrich & Perlman gave me a camera, Instamatic 104. I'll be darned. High 55°, nice day. Shopping at Target for film, etc.

Thu May 5 – EPS. High 82°, beautiful but windy. I mowed back yard. Helen had her hair washed & set. Letter from Mother. Card from Jim Coulombe

Fri May 6 – EPS. High in the 70s. Rode to work with Roger Schlaeppi, left our car home for Helen to pack for trip. Supper at Brookdale. Drove to Gerald's by 9:30 PM, 190 miles, to stay all night.

Sat May 7 – At Gerald's. Drove to Des Moines to Merle & Beulah's then to see Nancy Saddoris a few minutes. Lunch at Redwood Café at Urbandale & Merle Hay Road. To Osceola & Helen bought new shoes at Penney's. Marie came in the evening to Mother's awhile.

Sun May 8 – At Mother's. Mother & Clarence went to Nancy's today, in Des Moines, for dinner. We had dinner with Marie, at Warren's Café. Louie & Ruth here in the afternoon, also Wilma. We went to Wilma's for supper. Dalene called for Mother' Day.

Mon May 9 – Annual leave. Helen & I drove from Osceola to Burlington, Colorado, 550 miles. Good driving day, cool. Stopped at Kit Carson Motel in Burlington. At supper at Williams Café uptown.

Tue May 10 – Annual leave. Burlington, Colorado, to Socorro, New Mexico, 575 miles. Staying at the Vagabond Motel, a nice one. Wrote some cards.

Wed May 11 – Annual leave. Drove from Socorro, New Mexico, to Phoenix, 381 miles. Beautiful day. Through Salt River Canyon etc. Stopping at Desert Hills Motel, nice place. Helen talked to Baldwins & Francis Burger in the evening.

Thu May 12 – Annual leave. In Phoenix all day visiting Pierce & Alice Baldwin & Francis Burger. Supper, all of us, at Desert Hills coffee shop & then to Francis's house for a little while. Pierces took us a ride in the evening over the city; back to the motel at midnight. Beautiful day. Took several pictures.

Fri May 13 – Annual leave. Left Phoenix at 6 AM. Arrived San Diego 2 PM, 371 miles today. High in the desert was 90°, in San Diego about 70° & cloudy. Spent the afternoon & night at The Surfer Motel.

Sat May 14 – From San Diego to Laguna Beach to visit Rutenbeck a few minutes, then on to L.A. & Brentwood Motor Hotel 12:30 PM. 127 miles today, San Diego to L.A. Nice motel in Brentwood Heights. Went to lunch with Dalene. High temp about 65°. To supper with Dalene. Watched TV at Dalene's apartment until 10:30 then back to the motel.

Sun May 15 – A day of rest. Helen & I to breakfast at noon. Bought some groceries & took to Dalene's. Slept most of the afternoon. Supper at Dalene's apartment, she cooked it. Back to the motel a little after nine & to bed to read & watch TV.

Mon May 16 – Annual leave. Breakfast at Dalene's. Shopping in downtown Santa Monica. Temp in the low 70s & no smog. Evening at Dalene's.

Tue May 17 – Annual leave. In L.A. Helen washed at Dalene's. To the motel in the afternoon to rest. To a smorgasbord on Wilshire for supper. At Dalene's in the evening. Jack Woods, Dalene's friend, came in the evening to get acquainted. Back to the motel at 10:30 to read awhile. High in the 70s. Beautiful day.

Wed May 18 – Annual leave in L.A. Helen had her hair washed & set in Brentwood Heights. Lunch at Dalene's, she came home for lunch. Helen & I down on Wilshire Blvd. to buy some books. Steak supper at Dalene's. Mr. Puckett, & Jack Woods there too. Beautiful day, around high 70s.

Thu May 19 – Annual leave. In L.A. at the Brentwood motel. To Coffee Pot for breakfast. Helen & I to SDC to see Dalene's work. To the Valley shopping in Canoga Park. Took Dalene's spare tire to her at SDC. Supper at the Hasty Inn cafeteria. To the motel all evening. Hot in the Valley 86°.

Fri May 20 – Annual leave. In L.A. Brunch at noon at Coffee Cup. Had car greased & oil changed at Standard Station in Brentwood Heights. Helen fried a chicken in the apartment for supper. Talked to Bill & Leona by phone in the evening. High about 78°. Back to the motel at 10:30.

Sat May 21 – Up late in L.A. Brunch at Dalene's at noon. Put some thin blue covers on the side windows of the car to filter the sun. Supper at Dalene's. Vicki's mother there in the evening. Home at 10 PM. High about 75 & clear in the afternoon.

Sun May 22 – Breakfast at Dalene's. Back to the motel to clean the car & load it for tomorrow - starting home. Took Dalene to supper at Norm's, in Santa Monica. I had a steak. Visited Dalene & Vicki until 10 PM. High today about 70°.

Mon May 23 – Annual leave. L.A. to Winnemucca, Nevada, 618 miles. Drove up highway 395, no good for scenery, saw Mt. Whitney but not very impressive. Beautiful day for driving, clear & bright, & not hot. Nice Best Western motel here, on the west side of highway 40. Wrote some cards.

Tue May 24 – Annual leave. Winnemucca to Little America, Wyoming, 512 miles. Another beautiful day, just drove & drove. Lunch in Salt Lake City, getting 17 mpg - good. Supper at Little America & a good night's rest ahead. Temp in the 70s. Not hot anywhere along the way.

Wed May 25 – Annual leave. Through the Black Hills & a stop at Mt. Rushmore to Wall, South Dakota, 604 miles. Spent the night at the Fountain Motel. Helen called Lela at 9 PM, we'll be there tomorrow night. Beautiful day, perfect. Not hot & very little wind, clear.

Thu May 26 – Annual leave. Wall to Estherville by 6 PM, 406 miles. Stopped at Murdo, South Dakota, to see Zoe Williams but she wasn't home. Another beautiful day to drive. Supper with Gene & Lela at a drive-in. Warm today, about 90°. Visited until 12:30.

Fri May 27 – Annual leave. Bought some things at Gene's store in Estherville. Lunch in Mankato. Home at 3:30. Drove 4836 miles on this trip. Unloaded the car. Supper at Sweden House, out to Stan's a little while.

Sun May 29 – Showed the apartment to several, but no renters. Lots of telephone calls. Shopping at Spartan's for paint, etc. Painted the shower stall in the basement. High about 68° & beautiful. Wrote letters to Mother, & Karen Schaffer < daughter of Helen's nephew Don Schaffer >.

Mon May 30 – Holiday. Showed the apartment but no renters. Beautiful bright clear day. 70°.

Tue May 31 – EPS. Back to work after 3 week vacation. High 75° & beautiful. Rented the apartment to Mary Darling beginning July 1st. Supper at Sweden House. Talked to Dalene by phone in the evening.

Sun Jun 5 – Up late. Russ Crosby looked at the apartment & will paint it, maybe this week. Mowed the lawn, washed the car, bought some paint brushes at Holiday. Supper at Sweden House. Watched a movie, "Warlock." To bed 10:45.

Mon Jun 6 – EPS. High 70°. Bought some tri-sodium & washed apartment kitchen walls & woodwork.


Sun Jun 19 – Lazy day. Washed the car. Dalene called for Father's Day, so did Stan.

Dale painting storm windows


