Update on Osceola Restaurants

Andy's was mentioned only in 1971 and was (probably) Andy Gwinn's restaurant (see Simmerman's).

A & W – in Osceola in the 1950s; a drive-in on the north side of highway 34, about the 600 block of West McLane. In the late 1970s, it was a short order restaurant with inside seating, operated by John and Jennie Jones. They had good chili. Jennie now works at the casino and John has vending machines around town. They had the Jones Café before (see below).

B & H Café – in Osceola in the 1950s; north of the Whiteway Café, same side of the street. It had a horseshoe counter with 11 stools and 5 booths; Carol Gardner worked there in high school. The joke was that B and H stood for Belch and Heave, but those were the initials of the owners.

Beeman's is first mentioned in 1975 - at one time Dick and Mary Beeman had a drug store on the NE corner of the east side of the square, then they bought and operated the Dairy Queen on Highway 69 North. In 1975 they sold it and moved into a building on the south side of the square where a dental office was and opened a small sandwich and ice cream restaurant.

Byer's Restaurant is first mentioned in 1965; it was on Highway 34 about a quarter-mile east of I-35. Bob Byers was the owner. It became Opal Smith's in 1974, and in 1977 it was renamed Chef II, then in 1979 it became The Family Table. Mr. Byers built a Best Western motel (still there with a different name) next door.

Chef II is first mentioned in 1977 (see Byer's above).

Country Platter is first mentioned in 1978, and Country Table is first mentioned in 1980; they may have been named interchangeably by Dale; they were probably successors to Warren's (see below).

Derby is first mentioned in 1969; a restaurant in the town of Derby where two or three older women served home cooked mashed potatoes, noodles, etc. People flocked there, especially on weekends, and would stand in line to get in for the wonderful food.

Family Table is first mentioned in 1979 (see Byer's above).

Gus and Tom's is first mentioned in 1982 (see Mallot's below).

Hard Water Inn is first mentioned in 1987; it was a restaurant on Highway 69 north of Osceola, just outside city limits, where you could pick out your own steak.

Hotel Café is first mentioned in 1970; it was in the Osceola Hotel at the southwest corner of the square at the intersection of Fillmore and Jefferson. It became the Uptown Café in 1975.

Jones Café is first mentioned in 1974 (see Simmerman's below). See also A & W; same Joneses.

Latchstring is mentioned only in 1971 and nothing else is known about it. It may have been in Leon or Creston.

Li'l Duffer is first mentioned in 1980; a fast food drive-in on highway 34, more toward the Interstate. Clarke County State drive-in bank is there now.

Lunchbox Cafe is first mentioned in 1976 and was in a small building just south of the railroad crossing on Main Street. People named McGrew operated it for years then the Potts family bought it and had it for many years, known for great home cooking. Madlyne Potts made the best noodles, she rolled them

out on newspapers on the top of the deep freeze in the back of the café; her husband Bill had a rough gravely voice, they knew everyone and everything.

Mallot's is first mentioned in 1974 and was on Main Street in the middle of the east side of the square in the former JC Penney building. It became Gus and Tom's in 1982, and then Redman's restaurant.

Manley's is first mentioned in 1972 (see Warren's below).

Meal Site is first mentioned in 1978; it was for seniors, age 62 or older, on the west side of the square. Seniors without funds could wash dishes and /or set the table for their meal. For some, it was their one meal of the day.

Nelson's Corners is first mentioned in 1987 (see Warren's below).

Opal's is first mentioned in 1974 (see Byer's above).

Pleasant's is first mentioned in 1968 (see Warren's below).

Simmerman's is first mentioned in 1968; a restaurant on South Main across Jefferson from the east side of the square. It became Andy's in 1971 and was the Jones Café in 1974.

Warren's was the restaurant in the Champlain truck stop in the 1960s on the south side of Highway 34 about a quarter mile east of I-35, just west of Byer's. It was owned by Marshall Warren. The next owner was Ted Pleasant, and the restaurant became known as Pleasant's in 1968. Dale's diaries sometimes use the names "Warren's" and "Pleasant's" interchangeably. In 1972 it became Manley's (we think), then in about 1987 it was renamed "Nelson's Corners." The building is not there any more; a Casey's general store and gas station is there now. It is still often referred to as Champlain's or the truck stop.

Whiteway Café is first mentioned in 1970; on the east side of Main, a half-block north of the square.

Uptown Café is first mentioned in 1975 (see Hotel Café above).

Osceola Restaurant Name/Ownership Changes

Diary of Dale Gardner 1979

As this diary from 1979 begins, Dale and Helen live at 624 North State Street, Osceola, IA. Their neighbors are Don and Virginia Cole to the north, Jay and Tina Wolfe to the south, and "T. J." and Lois Laing across the street. Stan and Judy are divorced; Stan lives in Des Moines and works at Massey-Ferguson. Dalene lives in Manhattan Beach, CA, and works at Xerox Computer Services. Dale is 69 years old, Helen is 67, and they drive a 1978 Chevette.

Dale and Helen make an unplanned trip to Minneapolis to see Judy hospitalized for surgery for a brain aneurism; Dalene flies in too. Dalene also gets a one-year sabattical. State Street, in front of Dale and Helen's house, is paved. The circus comes to town and sets up in the empty field west of their house, behind the high school. The "Family Table" restaurant is mentioned in Dale's diaries for the first time. Stan marries Nancy Raymond in Dale and Helen's back yard - a marriage destined to be brief - and Stan leaves Massey Ferguson for a job in Cleveland, Ohio, with Standard Oil of Ohio. Dalene buys a 1973 VW "Bug," and Helen gets her first driver's license in 40 years. Jeff, still in the Navy, marries Mary Jane Hall in Memphis. Tennessee.

A mob attack destroys the U.S. Embassy in Islamabad, Pakistan; later, Pakistan's former Prime Minister, Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, is executed. The Sahara Desert experiences snow for 30 minutes. The first black-led government of Rhodesia in 90 years takes power and the country's name is changed to Zimbabwe. Iraq's President Hasan al-Bakr resigns and Vice President Saddam Hussein replaces him. Egypt's Anwar Sadat and Israel's Menachim Begin sign the first peace treaty between an Arab nation and the Jewish state. China institutes the one child per family rule to help control its exploding population. The price of oil reaches a new record of \$24 per barrel. Notable births this year include Claire Danes, Jennifer Love Hewitt, Kate Hudson, Norah Jones, Heath Ledger, and Brandon Routh.

Dale and Helen see many family members during the year, including Wilma and Mac McFarland; Marie and Ralph Kimmel; Vivian and Wayne Hanson; Lela Yates; Cathy Adair and Nikki; Mary Gardner; Marie White; Nancy Weekman; Margie and Jack Nish; Dorothy and Earl Schaffer; Ruth Schaffer; Susan and Doug Granner and Nathan; Louise and Jack Wilson; and Keith Schaffer.

Mon Jan 1 – Clear & cold, high 3° above. Stayed home for meals. Watched bowl games.

Tue Jan 2 – Started Mac's cars. Went to the Des Moines airport at night after Mac & Wilma.

Fri Jan 5 – Lunch at Chef II, supper at Manley's. Marie here, Ralph sick. Stan phoned at 11 PM to visit.

Sat Jan 6 – Went to Des Moines shopping. Visited Wayne & Vivian in the afternoon.

Sun Jan 7 – Watched pro football in the afternoon. Jerry called, Judy in the hospital with brain trouble.

Tue Jan 9 – Lunch & supper at Manley's. Marie ate supper with us. Received 6 cups from Dalene, a Christmas present.

Thu Jan 11 – Snow most all day. Jerry phoned, Judy has to have surgery next week. Helen phoned Stan & Dalene about Judy.

Sat Jan 13 – Blizzard all day. 8 to 10 inches of new snow & drifted. Stayed home all day. Jerry phoned about Judy; will be operated on Friday.

Sun Jan 14 – Lots of snow on the ground. Snow drift 8 inches above the fence in the back yard.

Tue Jan 16 – Went to Des Moines for a treatment for Helen's back. Delivered cracked corn & eggs to Wayne & Vivian. Talked to Jerry; & Dalene.

Wed Jan 17 – Drove from Osceola to Owatonna, Minnesota. Supper at a Country Kitchen, all night in the Country Hearth motel.

Thu Jan 18 – Drove from Owatonna to Mpls. Went to see Judy at the hospital. Staying at Jerry & Judy's house.

Fri Jan 19 – In Mpls. Drove to the airport for Dalene in heavy snow. Judy operated on for a brain aneurism, resting OK by evening.

Sat Jan 20 – More snow, in Mpls. Judy had a good day. I talked to Nickolay by phone.

Sun Jan 21 – Mostly cloudy in Mpls. Watched the Super Bowl on TV. Pittsburgh 35, Dallas 31. Diana Schmitt here in the evening.

Mon Jan 22 – Helen & I bought Dave a desk lamp & door mirror. Went to see Judy in the hospital.

Tue Jan 23 – Helen & I drove Judy's car to the hospital. Dalene staying with friends in Shoreview.

Wed Jan 24 – Drove home from Mpls by 6 PM. Stopped & shopped in Des Moines. Played pool at night. Good to be home.

Sat Jan 27 – Helen phoned Judy, she is home from her operation.

Sun Jan 28 – Dinner at home, Lela here for dinner. Lots of snow in the back yard. 14 inches (drift) above the 4 foot chain link fence.

Tue Jan 30 – Lunch at Chef II with Ralph & Marie. Worked on income tax in the afternoon.

Wed Jan 31 – Lunch at Whiteway, fried chicken. Supper at Manley's. Visited Mac & Wilma.

Sat Feb 3 – Mary took Marie to the hospital, we went to see her.

Sun Feb 4 – Stan & Nancy here at night, getting married in August.

Thu Feb 8 – Lunch at Chef II with Mac & Wilma. Watched Michigan beat Iowa 60 to 57 on TV.

Sat Feb 10 – Watched 2 hours of big band tunes, Tex Beneke, Helen O'Connell & Bob Eberly, 10:30 to 12:30 PM. Good. < Beneke played in the original Glenn Miller orchestra before World War II, and led it after the war. This performance was with former Jimmy Dorsey vocalists. >

Tue Feb 13 – Dalene phoned at night, she has a year off for other work.

Sat Feb 17 – Mac & Wilma, Lela, Helen & I to lunch at Chef II. Stan phoned about plans for marriage & apartment hunting, etc. Sent Dalene a letter.

Fri Feb 23 – To Des Moines for treatments & shopping. Visited Stan at work.

Thu Mar 1 – Nancy Weekman phoned from Indiana, will be here tomorrow.

Fri Mar 2 – Went to the Des Moines airport after Nancy, in Lela's car. Mac & Wilma took us to supper at Chef II for our 47th wedding anniversary.

Sat Mar 3 – Married 47 years ago tonight. Lunch at Chef II with Lela & Nancy, Mac & Wilma. Supper at Manley's with Stan & Nancy. Dalene phoned. Judy phoned.

Mon Mar 26 – Dalene phoned in the afternoon. Watched Michigan State beat Indiana for title at night.

Tue Mar 27 – Helen & I ate lunch at Meal Site for 75¢ each. Good meal. Supper at Manley's.

Thu Mar 29 – Lunch at Whiteway with Mac & Wilma, & Lela. Stormy at night.

Sat Mar 31 – Went to Des Moines to visit Wayne & Vivian. Early supper with Stan & Nancy at Denny's on Fleur.

Mon Apr 2 – Helen & I to Des Moines shopping for carpet. Supper at Manley's with Mac & Wilma.

Tue Apr 3 – Looked at Osceola & Woodburn for carpeting, found it at Woodburn.

Wed Apr 4 – Bought 59.56 square yards of carpet of Iowa Furniture of Woodburn. Lela & us took Mac & Wilma out to Chef II for supper, Wilma is 74 today.

Thu Apr 5 – Phoned Dalene to tell her about the new carpet.

Fri Apr 6 – Took Lela to Des Moines to visit Jackie at a Ramada Inn.

Sat Apr 7 – Helped Stan & Nancy move to an apartment on Park Avenue in Des Moines. Hauled 3 loads in the Chevette; 3 in Stan's Magnum; & 2 in Nancy's Honda.

Sun Apr 8 – Helen & I took the living room carpet up & folded it, some job. Stan & Nancy came in the afternoon. Supper at Manley's with them.

Wed Apr 18 – Helen & I to Des Moines to Bill Eggleston's funeral.

Sat Apr 21 – Phoned Stan to come tomorrow to help move furniture, etc.

Sun Apr 22 – Beautiful day. Moved everything out of the front room. Stan & Nancy helped. We all had supper at Manley's. Stopped to visit Mac & Wilma after supper.

Wed Apr 25 – New carpet installed. New RCA TV delivered at 5:45 PM. What a day. Mac & Wilma here. Dalene phoned at night.

Thu Apr 26 – Sawed 3 doors off to fit our new carpet. New carpet & TV are great.

Mon Apr 30 – Went to Des Moines shopping & to see Wilma in the hospital. Visited Wayne & Vivian.

Tue May 1 – Marie is 61 years old.

Wed May 2 - Took Mac & Wilma their mail to the Des Moines hospital. Visited Wayne & Vivian.

Fri May 4 – Went to Des Moines to see Wilma in the hospital. Watched pro basketball at night.

Sat May 5 – Dalene phoned, coming home July 28th for vacation.

Sun May 6 – Wilma came home from the hospital. Stan, Nancy, & Jeff here in the afternoon.



Mon Nov 12 – Went to Des Moines after Mac & Wilma at the airport, back from Texas. Visited Wayne & Vivian.


Wed Nov 14 – Mac & Wilma here, Mac drove the Chevette. Lela & us to lunch at Whiteway.
