Diary of Dale Gardner 1991

As this diary from 1991 begins, Dale and Helen live at 624 North State Street, Osceola, IA. Their neighbors are Don and Virginia Cole to the north, Tina Wolfe to the south (she moves out in July), and Harold Frey across the street. Stan and Sondra live in Cleveland Heights, OH, and Stan works at Standard Oil of Ohio in Cleveland. Dalene and Russ live in New York state and Dalene works at Buck Consultants. Dale is 81 years old, Helen is 79, and they drive a 1989 Chevrolet Cavalier.

Dale has his hernia surgery, and his weight drops 40 pounds to 130. Lela has an operation for her broken knee. During Dale's recovery, Helen services their furnace all by herself - a first. Dale orders and starts wearing hearing aids. He also has prostate surgery for an enlarged prostate, not cancer. Opal and Don Schaffer celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary. Neighbor to the south Tina Wolfe sells her house and moves out; new neighbors Beth and George Pederson move in. During the year, we lose these family members: Ruth Chandler (Glen Chandler's wife), Gene Marquis (Vera Wilson's husband), Juanita Bemis, and Jerry Kelly (Eva's husband).

Indian Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi is assassinated. UN sanctions are imposed against Libya in response to alleged involvement in Lockerbie bombing. Slovenia and Croatia declare independence from Yugoslavia; the Balkan War begins. Jeffrey Dahmer is arrested after the remains of 11 men and boys are found in his Milwaukee, Wisconsin, apartment. Former U.S. postal worker Joseph Harris kills his former girlfriend and her fiancé and two former co-workers at the post office in Ridgewood, New Jersey, which result in the phrase "going postal." Lech Walesa, the Polish Workers President, is elected President of Poland. Terry Waite, the special envoy of the archbishop of Canterbury, is released after more than four years of captivity. The Internet is made available to unrestricted commercial use and the number of computers on the net reaches one million. Microsoft releases MS DOS 5.0.

Tue Jan 1 – Bad upset stomach this morning. Keith took Helen to a café for food. Phoned Dalene.

Sat Jan 5-5 inches of snow last night. Ron Gray plowed the driveway. Helen and I balanced the checkbook. Marie was in the hospital for heart trouble Thursday and Friday.

Fri Jan 11 – More snow. Ron cleared the driveway, 2nd time. We phoned Dalene.

Tue Jan 15 – Went to doctor, he will set a date for hernia operation. Helen phoned Gerald.

Wed Jan 16 – Joan McCann figured our income tax. We owe State, will get refund from Federal.

Thu Jan 17 – Had an EKG test at hospital, also a blood test. Operation will be at 9:30 AM on Monday.

Sat Jan 19 – We ate at Family Table. Lela here, she brought an interview by Bob; it was very, very impressive to me. Bob Yates retired from the FBI.

Sun Jan 20 – Getting ready to go to the hospital tomorrow.

Mon Jan 21 – Operated on for the hernia at Clarke County Hospital by Dr. Zugaren.

Tue Jan 22 – In the hospital. Lost hearing in my left ear, also partly in my right ear.

Wed Jan 23 – Had a bad night, my back & legs hurt bad. Lela operated on for a broken knee in Des Moines.

Tue Jan 29 – Back home from the hospital. Blood pressure 116/72. <u>I weigh 130 pounds</u>. County health nurse here in the afternoon. Stan came at night.

Wed Jan 30 – County health nurse here. Stan bought a new Mr. Coffee for us.

Mon Feb 11 – Home from the hospital. Stan here.

Tue Feb 12 – County health nurse here in the afternoon. Stan here.

Wed Feb 13 – I walked ½ mile. Louise here. I have a 26 inch waist!


Thu Feb 14 – Stan went home at 7:15 AM. He phoned at 9:30 PM from home in Cleveland. We were sure relieved. County health nurse here in the afternoon, blood pressure 122/70.

Fri Feb 15 – Marie here. Wrote Dalene a letter with a picture.

Mon Feb 18 – Keith brought us groceries. Coles left for Arizona.

Tue Feb 19 – County health nurse here. I weigh 138 pounds, blood pressure 128/76.

Fri Feb 22 – Helen baked a chicken & a meat loaf.

The weather has been very nice - sunny and warm every day. We've visited with Matt each day, gone birding and sightseeing, too. We went to the San Diego Zoo, to the top of Point Loma (where this picture was taken), took a drive into the desert; had a good time."

Sun Feb 24 – I drove us to grocery shopping. Marvin McHarg visited us. Dalene phoned.

Mon Feb 25 – We made some copies of checks to send to Dalene, etc. Phoned her in the evening.

Tue Feb 26 – County health nurse here. Larry & Irene phoned in the evening.

Wed Feb 27 – Stan phoned. Helen phoned Gerald.

Thu Feb 28 – Drove to the store & also to Family Table for supper. Phoned Dalene.

Fri Mar 1 – Helen cleaned the furnace filter, greased the fan bearings, & oiled the motor - by herself.

Sun Mar 3 – Married 59 years ago today. Dalene & Russ phoned. I weigh 145.

Mon Mar 4 – I weigh 146. January 29th I weighed 130 pounds. Had ear test by Greg Lamp & ordered 2 hearing aids. Went to the doctor & he gave me a clean bill of health.

Tue Mar 5 – In Methodist Hospital in Des Moines all afternoon, interviewing Dr. Hornaday & X-rays & lots of other tests from 1:30 to 5 PM. Keith took us. Phoned Stan & Dalene.

Wed Mar 6 – I talked to county health nurse, Kathie. Dalene phoned about the food she is sending.

Fri Mar 8 – Finally got the checkbook balanced with the bank so I can understand it.

Sat Mar 9 – Helen had a chiro treatment. Ate at Family Table.

Mon Mar 11 - I have to be at Methodist Hospital in Des Moines tomorrow by 6 AM for prostate surgery. Keith is going to take us.

Tue Mar 12 – I'm in Methodist Hospital. Had prostate surgery by Dr. Hornady, took 40 minutes. Spinal. < He had BPH (benign prostate hyperplasia) or enlarged prostate, not cancer; this surgery removed part of the prostate through the urethra - he later said he "got reamed out" >.

Wed Mar 13 – Long night. Got up & walked a little. Took medication & felt pretty good. Drank a lot.

Thu Mar 14 – In Methodist Hospital. Doctor took catheter out. What a relief. Minister took me to see Eugene Marguis on the same floor.

Fri Mar 15 – Home from the hospital. So glad to be home. Keith & Helen brought me home.

Sat Mar 16 – Ate at Family Table. Bought a new billfold. Helen baked a chicken & made a meat loaf.

Sun Mar 17 – Bought an apple pie at Family Table. Ate lunch there too.

Mon Mar 18 – I got 2 new hearing aids today. Phoned Dalene & Stan.

Mon Apr 8 – I greased the garage door & it hurt my legs; ladder work. Helen had a chiro treatment.

Sat Apr 13 – Rainy day. Phoned Dalene & Russ in the evening.

Sun Apr 14 – Stan phoned about 8:45 PM.

Mon Apr 15 – Florence Hawkins mowed our lawn, first time this year. Margie here in the afternoon.

Wed Apr 17 – Judy phoned, Dalene phoned offering to take us to Mpls for the wedding on May 25th.
